## Questions & Answers

**Q:** Do you offer any archery lessons?

**A:** Our regular classes start in September and end in late April. Adults and Juniors are welcome to join. Courses are usually offered on Monday evenings and Saturday mornings.

**Q:** Are there any activities over the summer months?

**A:** Our summer program runs from June to August with classes every Saturday morning from 10:30 to noon. The cost is \$ 10.00 per person for non-members.

**Q:** Are there any fees for these programs?

**A:** All programs are included in the annual membership fee.

**Q:** Apart from the regular classes and the summer program, are there any other club activities?

**A:** There are many special events throughout the year. From Fun Shoots to FCA approved competitive events, from Junior to Adult Shoots, and from local to province & national events.

**Q:** What is the best time to become a member?

**A:** We are accepting membership applications all year around but the best time is in September, since we are offering the remaining months for free with the following year's membership.

**Q:** Do I have to have my own equipment?

**A:** No, your membership includes the use of club equipment. You do have to purchase an arm guard, finger tab, and arrows but only after 6 weeks into the lesson plan at a cost of around \$60.00.

**Q:** When do I have access to the facilities and the equipment?

**A:** Members receive a key for the facility and club equipment storage. Access is 24/7.

**Q:** What are the requirements to join the club?

**A:** Because we are a non-profit club and run with a 100% volunteer base, we do expect all members to contribute some time in running the club. This can be in areas such as Fundraising, Event Duties, Phoning, Website, Coaching, Scoring, Concession, Canbow Program, Cleaning, Handyman, or Lawn Maintenance.
